It's my pleasure to welcome you to the sixth edition of BEP Newsletter. This edition is special in many ways. Firstly, it conveys a message of good will to ALL BEP students sitting public exams in 2017; from SATS, GCSE to A Level. Secondly, it carries an exciting news about BEP collaboration and partnership with the Museum Of London and finally, it introduces BEP first ever Summer School which will commence from 1st August to 31st August 2017.

Needless to say that EXAM TIME is one of the most challenging moments when students start getting anxious and spend sleepless nights worrying about the coming exams. Exams may be anxiety provoking for some people. Students may worry about an exam for days before it is to take place and/or during the exam, when tackling the examination they may experience negative thoughts and unpleasant physical symptoms which prevent them from performing to the best of their ability. My advise is, **KEEP CALM IT'S JUST EXAM FEVER!** Students, Just Relax! Need not Worry.... It is wise to remember that exams are not here as punishment. Instead, they are a good way of testing to see how much information you have learnt.

Don't get over anxious: It never helps. Think of all the exams you have faced so far and how you have overcome your fears. Visualise the worst that can happen and then think positive.

Talk over your anxieties to your parents, friends etc and get it out of your chest periodically. At the same time, talk about the subjects you are good in and the chapters you are well prepared in. Gain confidence in subjects you know best: by completing the revision and writing notes, especially to a family member or answering mock tests. Make brief points to refer just before the exams. Fix time and place: Make sure that your study has no disturbance.

Move away from that place when you need to take breaks. Take them frequently by structuring your time schedule. Every time you feel fresh, study the difficult or boring subjects first for a few minutes and then move on to easy ones.

THE CITY IS OURS RESEARCH PROJECT FOR 14 -18 YEARS OLD.

BEP Education is constantly exploring opportunities for partnership and collaborative working with external organisations. Few months ago we brought in Birkbeck University of London as partners with BEP. They delivered a presentation on career paths to our young people during Barnfield Youth and Education Day. This month, we've again succeeded in bringing in Museum Of London as our partners. This has resulted in immediate commissioning of BEP education by the Museum Of London to take part in a Nation-wide research project - The City Is Ours. This research project will provide our young people a rare opportunity to take part in a creative research that will help them explore the city they live in, the challenges faced by young people and most importantly, to come up with a proposal on the type of city they would like to have in the future - This is an exciting news!

At the completion of this 6 months research project participants will not only receive joint certificate from BEP Education and Museum Of London but, will gain invaluable skills that will go into their CV, UCAS applications and key employability skills such as analytical skills, communication skills and team-working skills. 

Attendance

Please be reminded that once your child register with us, they are expected to attend Saturday school every weekend. You will still be charged if your child is absent, however we may discretionary waver the contribution if your child is off due to illness, this will be assess on a case by case basis. Unauthorised absence is not permitted in any form; if your child is not able to attend for any reason including sickness please, ring the school office and report your son/daughter's absence. Regarding punctuality, BEP takes punctuality very seriously, therefore; we are appealing to all parents to remind their children to get to class on time, classes starts 10:00am prompt!

This initiative will enable parents to get involve in their children's learning. By making sure that all parents provide all resources and equipment needed by their children for learning. Members of PASS visit the school on Saturday during lesson to see how learning takes place. They are responsible for spreading the news and supporting other parents who are not supportive of their children's education.

The use of inter-generational approach

This initiative help parents to learn some basic computer skills from our most able students. Students who are bright with excellent IT and computer skills are selected to teach parents. Students are not allocated to teach their biological parents but other parents to ensure inter-transfer of knowledge from one generation to another.
